


Control the EagleCam from your home computer

Go to the Village's home page, www.crotononhudson-ny.gov, and click the **EagleCam** button under "On Our Site." Or paste this link into your browser www.crotononhudson-ny.gov/eaglecam. Canon's VC-C50i camera delivers high-quality video from far distances and under the dimmest lighting conditions.
