

Instructions:

1. Attach site plan, drawn to scale, showing the specific location for all live trees six (6) inches in diameter or larger, measured at a point three (3) feet above existing ground level prior to regarding the area and along the 25-foot wide boundary strip around the grading area, with a note for each tree indicating removal or not.
2. Site plan shall be prepared by licensed engineer or land surveyor and shall show the location and dimension of the premises to a point 10 feet beyond the boundaries thereof and showing distances from street or highway lines, distance from boundary lines of other owners, the proposed location, size and use of any existing buildings thereon and cross-sections and elevations appropriate to indicate the effect of the operation upon the contour and grade of the premises and upon the relationship in the contour and grade between the affected portion of the premises and the remainder of such property and any abutting land and highways after completion of the operation.
NOTE: The Village Engineer shall have the right to waive the necessity of furnishing a topographical map. (Sec. 120-4.E.)
3. Attach duly acknowledged written consent of the owner and mortgagee, if any, of the premises of the proposed operation.
4. Attach Certificates of the Village Treasurer and Town Receiver of Taxes showing payment of all taxes and assessments to date against the premises. (120-4.G.)
