- 1. One person at a time should speak and others should please be respectful of that person's time. If you are speaking, please observe the given time allotment.
- 2. Respect others 'opinions; if you disagree and wish to voice that, please do so in a kind and non-aggressive manner.
- 3. We ask that you speak from "I" and "me" rather than from "they" and "them".
- 4. We request honesty and compassion.
- 5. We focus primarily on social issues of diversity and inclusion, as they impact our Croton community. It is not a forum for issues of an international nature, but rather for locally focused exchange of thoughts and ideas.
- 6. We encourage creating a sense of togetherness and strongly discourage words or actions that promote division.
- 7. If hateful, malicious, racist, or antagonistic, or otherwise disruptive behaviors occur during our meetings, our moderators reserve the right to remove participants to preserve order.
- 8. Although we cannot guarantee confidentiality, we ask participants please respect the privacy of what anyone says in these meetings; that will encourage the honest communications we hope for.
