General Meeting Summary
September 22, 2022

At the September, 22, 2022, LHC meeting—our first after our summer hiatus—attendees caught up with one another, both personally and professionally. All who attended this meeting expressed enthusiasm for work in the upcoming year on a variety of LHC initiatives. At this meeting, Maria Modica-Snow passed the baton to Lynda Jones and Signe Bergstrom, announcing them as the coalition's new co-chairs. The group also welcome Katherine Randel from the larger D&I group, who spoke about D&I's plans for the upcoming Fall Fast; the LHC and the D&I are sharing space at the event.

The coalition went over old business, covered internal housekeeping issues related to the web site, minutes, grants/proposals, and record-keeping, and broadly discussed a few of 2023's events and projects, including the Temple Event, an LHC-mounted exhibit/event that will commemorate the 60th anniversary of 1963's Rally to Support the Southern Freedom Movement at which Lorraine Hansberry was the chairperson. The event took place at Temple Israel of Northern Westchester. A decision was made to hold a separate brainstorming session on September 27, 2022, to discuss the event in more detail.
