## FAQ's

**Q. How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?**

A. Guns must be UNLOADED and placed in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

**Q. Can I transport the firearm in a car?**

A. Yes, it must be UNLOADED and in the trunk in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

**Q. How many firearms can I surrender?**

A. As many as you wish to provide.

**Q. Can any member of the public surrender a gun?**

A. Licensed gun dealers, and active or retired law enforcement officers are not eligible for this program.

**Q. Do I need any identification to turn in a firearm?**

A. No, this is an Amnesty program, and no questions are asked of the person dropping off the firearm.
