Parking Department Quarterly Report September 1, 2021 – November 30, 2021

Daily Transactions at the Croton Harmon Train Station Parking Lot:

There were 23,258 transactions with revenue totaling \$238,642.70.

The daily parking account revenue for the first two quarters of the year is now at 145.48% of our projected annual budget. The daily parking was budgeted conservatively this year as the Village did not know at what level employees would return to work and use mass transit.

Quarterly Permit Parking at the Croton Harmon Train Station Parking Lot:

Preferred Parking Permits Sold: 35 Resident Parking Permits Sold: 277 Non-Resident Parking Permits Sold: 565

Total Revenue: \$247,986

The permit parking account revenue for the first two quarters of the year is now at 69.96% of our projected annual budget. This amount includes payments for three permit cycles. With one permit cycle remaining (in February), it is likely that this account will be slightly under budget for the fiscal year.
