RECISSION OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

Whereas, a State of Emergency was declared in the Village of Croton-on-Hudson on March 16, 2020, for a period of time effective immediately and continuing for the next thirty days; and

Whereas, the State of Emergency was declared due to emergency conditions produced by the COVID-19 outbreak; and

Whereas, such emergency declaration has been extended every 30 days as required by law and remains in effect; and

Whereas, the Village Board of Trustees adopted Local Law 9 of 2020 on November 16, 2020, which provided for the creation of Chapter 158 of the Village Code, Masks and Face Coverings; and

Whereas, such local law provides for the Village Manager to declare a public health emergency before such local law can be placed into effect; and

Whereas, the Village Manager declared that a Public Health Emergency exists within the Village of Croton-on-Hudson effective 12:01 a.m. on December 15, 2020; and

Whereas, such emergency declaration has been extended every 30 days as required by law and remains in effect; and

Whereas, conditions that necessitated the issuance of the public health emergency have abated due to the widespread availability of the COVID-19 vaccine,

Now, therefore, it is hereby declared that the Public Health Emergency that has existed within the Village of Croton-on-Hudson is hereby rescinded as of 12:01 a.m. on April 29, 2021.
