Parking Department Quarterly Report March 01, 2023 – May 31, 2023

Daily Transactions at the Croton Harmon Train Station Parking Lot:

There were 36,738 transactions with revenue totaling \$384,476.35

The daily parking account revenue for all four quarters of the year is now at 159.9% of our projected annual budget. As more employees commute into the city on intermittent schedules, we have seen this account exceed its budgeted amount.

Quarterly Permit Parking at the Croton Harmon Train Station Parking Lot:

Preferred Parking Permits Sold: 38 Resident Parking Permits Sold: 333 Non-Resident Parking Permits Sold: 695

Total Revenue: \$310,654.33

The permit parking account revenue for all four quarters of the year is now at 117.6% of our projected annual budget. This amount includes payments for all four permit cycles. We have seen an increase in permit parking, which has contributed to this account surpassing its budgeted amount for this year.
