

## **Parking Department Quarterly Report**

**September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 – November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

- **Daily Transactions at the Croton Harmon Train Station Parking Lot:**

Between September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019 there were 47,081 transactions with revenue totaling \$488,903

This amount represents 52.98% of our projected annual budget.

- **Quarterly Permit Parking September-November, 2019 at the Croton Harmon Train Station Parking Lot:**

Preferred Parking Permits Sold: 71

Resident Parking Permits Sold: 639

Non-Resident Parking Permits Sold 1111

Total Revenue: \$507,323.42

This amount represents 50.63% of our projected annual budget.

Total Quarterly Revenue: \$ 1135.00
