

PUBLIC WORKS QUARTERLY REPORT

Fiscal Year 2018/2019

First Quarter: June 1, 2018 – August 31, 2018

Below is a brief highlighted list of tasks completed during the third quarter of 2018:

Highway

- Support of Summer Fest
- Swept 531 miles of roadway
- Removed and replaced banners for various Village events
- Cleaned out 77 catch basins
- Repaired 4 catch basins
- Installed new 25 mph speed signs
- Weekly asphalt maintenance (potholes and water patches)
- Summer cleanup of parking lot (remove weeds, trim trees, sweep entire lot, straighten guardrails)
- Striped all crosswalks and stop bars throughout the Village
- Continued on the streetlight LED replacement project
- Repair of collapsed drain line on Arrowcrest Drive
- Replacement of approximately 140 linear feet of concrete sidewalk through the Village 50/50 program
- Trimmed approximately 10 trees
- Removed approximately 3 trees

Sanitation:

- Collected approximately 909 tons of refuse
- Weekly collection of Village co-mingled, paper and metal recycling

Building Maintenance:

- Started the conversion of the Municipal Building lighting to LED (through NYS grant)
- Weekly maintenance and cleaning of Nordica pump station
- Assistance with the renovation of the new DPW facility

Water Department:

- Repaired two water leaks
- Submission of monthly reports to Westchester County
- Hydrant flushing in certain areas of the Village
- Continued with the implementation of the new Corrosion Control system

Parks Department:

- Mowed lawns/field in all Village parks
- Litter removal in Village parks and fields
- Support of weekly concerts, movies and entertainers at Senasqua Park
- Installation of new benches at Croton Landing

Repair Facility:

- Preparing all necessary vehicles and equipment for the upcoming leaf season
- Preparing the new DPW facility for moving the garage
- Weekly inspection and maintenance of all police vehicles
- Assist Fire Department with vehicle maintenance
- Purchase of new back hoe (approved during the past budget cycle)

Capital Projects:

- Administered and inspected the High Street/Hillside drainage replacement project
- Worked with the Engineering firm to start the design of the Washington Engine roof replacement
- Continued working towards the final design documents for the Grand Street Firehouse drainage improvements
- Continued with the parking lot redevelopment plan for the eventual demolition of the existing DPW facility
- Continued with renovations of the new DPW facility
