MISSION STATEMENT

It is the mission of the Village of Croton-on-Hudson Recreation Department: to create and maintain aesthetically pleasing, safe, healthful, and enjoyable areas for residents; to provide positive, cost effective leisure opportunities which promote individual and community wellness for children, youth, adults and seniors; to promote the preservation and appropriate utilization of the Village's recreational resources.

The Recreation Department provides and plans for year-round classes, programs and special events.

Some of the highlights for this quarter were:

- Held 32 classes/programs and special events.
- Successful Spring Celebration with approximately 250+ in attendance.
- Introduced four new classes: two for adults - Intro to Pottery & Yin-Yang Yoga and two youth classes - Ultimate Frisbee & Indoor Soccer Clinic.
- Summerfest Parade was the biggest in recent memory.
- Seniors had their first charter bus trip in over 3 years.
- Two additional Canoe/Kayak racks were added at Echo Canoe Launch increasing total number of slips available to 78. All of them have been sold.
