Draft Local Waterfront Revitalization Program Amendment

A. Local and Regional Agencies and Individuals

No Comments were received from local and regional agencies and individuals.

B. State Agencies

1. NYS Department of Transportation

Comment: It is indicated that the LWRP adequately addresses New York State Department of Transportation's (NYSDOT) role (amendment draft report, pages VI-12 to-VI-13). On a specific level for NYSDOT activities involving design, construction and maintenance, NYSDOT would coordinate with the village and perform required consistency reviews with the village and NYSDOS as necessary.

Response: None needed.

C. Federal Agencies

1. Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Coast Guard

Comment: It is indicated that the Croton-on-Hudson LWRP appears to have no effect on U.S. Coast Guard related activities or missions in the area. The U.S. Coast Guard will conduct ice breaking operations on the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton-on-Hudson. The U.S. Coast Guard will provide formal comments during the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Public Notice comment period for future waterfront projects.

Response: Activities that are subject to the consistency provisions of the federal Coastal Zone Management Act, implementing regulations in 15 CFR Part 930, Subpart D and the New York State Coastal Management Program will be reviewed by NYS Department of State if permits, licenses, or other forms of authorization or approval is required. The U.S. Coast Guard will be consulted on any proposed projects or actions that may affect their activities or missions. **No LWRP revisions have been made.**

2. United States Geological Survey
