VILLAGE OF CROTON-ON-HUDSON, NEW YORK RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG PARK AREA IN BLACK ROCK PARK

Hours of Operation: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday from April 1 – September 30, and 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. from October 1 – March 31.

Dogs are only allowed in Black Rock Park during the hours of operation and subject to the following rules:

- Use of this park with a dog requires a special use permit from the Village Clerk's Office, which is available to Village residents only who are the owners of a licensed dog.
- Recreation ID Card with a valid permit sticker must be carried when using the facility.
- Dogs must be properly licensed, inoculated and healthy. All puppies younger than six months of age are prohibited from using the park.
- Dogs must wear collars and license tags at all times.
- Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them.
- Dogs must be accompanied by an owner 18 years old or older.
- Owners may bring no more than three dogs at any one time to the park.
- Dogs must be leashed upon leaving their car and walked into the fenced portion of the park. At that point, they may be unleashed. Dogs must be leashed before exiting the fenced portion of the park.
- Owners must clean-up after their dogs and dog waste must be bagged and disposed of in the trash receptacles at the park.
- Dogs showing aggression towards people or other animals should be removed from the park by their owner and not permitted to re-enter.
- Owners must not leave dogs unattended or allow their dogs out of sight in the park.
- Dogs in heat are not permitted in the park.
- Owners must carry a dog leash at all times and have their dog(s) under voice control.
- The gate to the park must be kept closed at all times.
- Excessive noise or barking is not permitted in the park. At the request of a Village employee, a barking dog may be asked to leave the park. Continued excessive barking on more than one occasion will result in revocation of the permit.
- Owners are responsible to fill in any hole dug by their dog.
- Any dog in the park area at the time in which the lawn maintenance crew arrives is to be leashed and removed from the area until the lawn care is completed. The owner and dog may wait in the parking lot until it is clear to re-enter the park.

Violation of any of the Black Rock Park rules and regulations may result in the revocation of the special use permit and the issuance of a summons with an associated fine up to \$250.00.
