A Trip to Ever Rest, Home Of Jasper Cropsey

Jasper Cropsey was a well-known Hudson River School painter in the mid-19th Century. His landscapes reflected his interest in the influence of nature on man's existence, a concept that was fundamental to Hudson River School artists like Thomas Cole and Asher B. Durand. When tastes in painting shifted toward Impressionism, Cropsey's financial situation faltered, and in 1884 the family settled in Hastings-on-Hudson, New York, in a house they called Ever Rest, where Cropsey and his wife lived together until they died. Ever Rest is listed on the National Register of Historic Homes. This trip is part of a monthly series featuring sites of interest along the Old Croton Aqueduct.
